

Some Headlines from the Student Voice B&S Survey December 2014

- a) 224 pupils surveyed
- b) 94% of pupils said they felt safe in school
- c) 89% of pupils said they felt happy in school
- d) 88% of pupils said that if they had a problem in school they know who to see/where to go
- e) 84% said students behaved well in their lessons

Areas where a minority of students are looking for improvements include the condition of the tennis courts area outside, the toilets in school, and conduct on the school buses.

The tennis courts have a worn surface after many years of use, and mud has accumulated on them making the area unsafe and unfortunately out of bounds in the short term, but it is hoped this situation will be remedied soon.

The condition of toilets in school are monitored regularly, and students are encouraged to report any concerns asap to any member of the teaching staff or the site staff, and this will be a priority over the coming term.

In terms of conduct on the buses, school will act in support of the good behaviour which is expected from all students. Any concerns raised in relation to bus conduct are followed up and consequences have been, and will continue to be, put in place where necessary to support this. Poor behaviour on buses will not go unchallenged.

These findings will be shared in school with the wider student population via assemblies, as well as appearing on our website.
