Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to invite you to attend an information evening about **E-safety**.

E-safety involves learning about how to minimise the risks associated with the use of all technologies such as mobile phones, tablets, computers and wearable devices for young people. This is part of our commitment to safeguarding in school. As students get older, the safeguarding risks posed by technology become greater.
