- Do NOT go to morning registration if there is a session 1 examination. You will be registered in the exam. Make your way to the examination soon as the registration bell rings. The corridors around the Sports Hall will be closed in preparation for the exams. Please use an alternative route. There will be no entry to the Sports Hall via the doors from E block.
- Bags and coats should be left in the garage opposite the Fitness Suite. This will be locked for the duration of the exam.
- Make sure you have all the equipment you need for the exam with you e.g. pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, mathematical equipment and calculator, stored in a transparent pencil-case or bag. We are unable to provide any equipment for use in the exam unless yours breaks.
- Re-enter the school via the door by the boys changing rooms and line up in the corridor alongside the gym. Wait to be called through to the exam hall.
- You will be told your seat number in the week before the exams and lists will be displayed in the gym corridor for you to check before you go in. You will not sit in the same seat for the whole week so make sure you check the lists carefully.
- You must be silent as soon as you are called through from the corridor. Exam conditions will apply. If you have a mobile phone, ipod or similar with you, you MUST make sure it is turned off and place it in the basket at the front of the row you are sitting in. It can be collected on your way out.
- The exam will be run by external invigilators who are employed by the school to invigilate our exams. They are members of staff and you should follow their instructions at all times.
- Exams will start no later than 9.10am in session 1 and 11.30am in session 2.
- You are expected to return to your scheduled lesson at the end of the exam once you have collected your belongings from the garage. Please do so quickly and quietly so lessons are not disturbed.
- No exams in Art, IT, MFL, D&T, Food, Music, PE or Drama taking place in the Sports Hall. Your teacher will advise you if you will be taking some form of assessment in the classroom.
