Year 7 Spring Interim Assessment 1

Your child's February assessment is now available on SIMs Learning Gateway. It contains information about your child's end of Year 7 and Key Stage 3 minimum expected target levels, the level your child is currently working at in each subject as well as details of your child's effort and behaviour this half-term. In this profile current levels have been colour coded:

Green indicates that your child is on track to exceed their target level in that subject by the end of the year.

Amber indicates that your child is on track to achieve their target level in that subject by the end of the year.


Red indicates that your child is performing below target in that subject and is not currently on track to reach their target level by the end of the year.

The Government is no longer providing schools with KS3 and GCSE targets based on the KS2 results, so Helsby High School is piloting a new system of target setting using the results of the CAT4 tests that the students sat in September. With any new system there can be teething problems and so we will be grateful for any feedback with regards your child's targets and current levels so that we can make the necessary adjustments to ensure that the system meets the needs of students and parents.
