Post 16 Options:

- Careers Advisor available for appointments. She began interviewing pupils with greatest need in Year 10 and has continued throughout the year.
- She has attended Consultation Evenings.
- Careers Convention
- Extra Careers appointments with CWAC advisor arranged by ASH
- Talks to students by doctor, lawyer, journalist – ongoing programme
- Talk in Assembly by TTE Apprenticeships
- Apprenticeship appointments on website

Communication

- HOY contacts parents regularly by phone, e-mail, letter and meetings – often seeing parents
- HOY available before 8.00am and after 3.05pm phone calls are also made from home in the evening.

Assessment and Reporting

- MYCAS – extra reporting
- End of year reports contain strengths and areas for development
- Most marking includes feedback (oral or/and written)
- Training of interim assessments and Consultation Evening could be reviewed

Consultation Evenings

- Any pastoral concerns are dealt with asap and parents are contacted with update.
- Appointment system can be problematic. Some parents skip queue or turn up late for appointments
- With pupil's now encouraged to attend – appointments can take longer than before
- Some pupils write down names of teachers incorrectly causing confusion – appointments could be made on-line
- Another option – extend the evening by an hour
