Anne-Marie Imafidon is a woman on a mission campaigning to get more women into Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM).

Anne-Marie attended universities on both sides of the Atlantic (John Hopkins University in the US) and was awarded her Masters degree in Mathematics and Computer Science by the University of Oxford aged 20.

Anne-Marie is Head Stemettes and co-founder of Stemettes – an award-winning social enterprise inspiring the next generation of females into Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics roles via a series of events and opportunities. As part of the initiative she has also co-founded Outbox Incubator: the world's first tech incubator for teenage girls. She sits on the boards of Redfield Asset Management, Urban Development Music Foundation and Inspirational YOU.

She was also named the UK IT Industry & British Computer Society's Young IT Professional of the Year in 2013, Red Magazine's 'Woman to Watch' 2014, won a Points of Light award from the UK Prime Minister in October 2014 and was named the 29th Most Influential woman in IT in 2015.
