

Oh Doris!

Many readers will already be aware that the Community Centre roof was damaged during the storm on the 23rd February. A third of the felt covering was blown off allowing widespread water ingress badly affecting the Main Hall.



It was necessary to isolate all electrics in the hall, cover the floor and activate water containment (buckets and bins) preventing significant flooding.



Debris has now been removed and temporary sheeting on the roof is in place to reduce water ingress.

Currently measures are being taken to prevent further damage and EBL is preparing a report for the insurance company and a view on whether a higher integrity temporary repair can be implemented. We can't consider using the Main Hall until we are sure all is water tight and safe and secure.

All bookings were cancelled for two days but the smaller rooms are now open allowing most events and meetings to take place.

All imminently affected bookings have been notified and we're doing our best to keep everyone up to date but please be patient if there are room changes.

It is thanks to the effort of a small team of volunteers that more damage has not occurred and their efforts are very much appreciated.
