Raising the Roof

As many of you will be all too aware our main hall is still out of use due to the damage sustained to the roof covering as a result of storm Doris. I'm sure it will appear that little progress is being made but in practice the situation is a little like the duck paddling against the current, working hard underneath with little to show above!

We would like to again apologise to everyone who has been inconvenienced by the hall being out of use and thank you for the understanding you have shown.

We are hoping normal service will resume mid April.

We were very grateful for the temporary protection put in place so quickly by EBL, which has saved a significant amount of internal damage, but there is still some water ingress. Remedial work will also be required to the acoustic wall cladding, ceiling tiles and possibly some electrical fittings.

Following a visit and report from their loss adjuster an agreement has been reached with our insurers and we have authority to proceed with repairs. Careful consideration has been given to the most suitable technical solution taking into account current building regulations, energy efficiency and service life.

The current situation is that, subject to material deliveries, the installation of a new steel sheeted roof covering will begin week commencing 27th March.

Clearly the installation work is subject to a number of factors, not least the weather, but it is anticipated the work will take 2-3 weeks. Following this the internal electrical installations, which are currently isolated, will have to be tested and certified safe before we can return the hall to use, other remedial work can then be planned accordingly.
