### **Year 11 Study Skills Day and Evening (6.30-8.30pm) Event – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2018**

As you will be aware, we wrote to you on Consultation Evening to inform you and your son/daughter of the Year 11 Study Skills day and evening event on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January. After receiving some parental and student voice we have decided to adapt this evening to include advice and guidance for future destinations. The Study Skills day, in school, will still continue, as explained in the original letter.

The evening will now be split into 2 parts, depending on the form class your son/daughter is in. Part 1 of the evening will be a study skills session that aims to provide parents and students with a range of revision and memory techniques to enable more effective learning to take place leading up to the GCSE examinations.

Part 2 of the evening will provide an opportunity for you to meet and talk with representatives of organisations in Higher Education, Law and the Construction Trades. It will also be an opportunity to find out more about apprenticeships, including Degree level apprenticeships and the application process. There will be 6 sessions to choose from on the evening, each lasting 20 minutes. Due to time constraints you will only have the opportunity to attend a maximum of 3 sessions.

The sessions available are:

1. An introduction to Apprenticeships/ How to apply for an Apprenticeship
2. Degree Level Apprenticeships (LJMU)
3. University – Studying for a degree/ Life as a University student (Liverpool University/ LJMU)
4. STEM Professional Careers in Construction (Townsend and Turner)
5. Careers in Law (University of Law )
6. Careers in the Armed Services (RAF)

**Students in 11DHE, 11MRA, 11MMS and 11CZO** will attend Part 1 of the evening (Study Skills) from 6.30 – 7.30pm, then select 3 sessions for Part 2 of the evening (Advice and Guidance for Future Destinations) from 7.30 – 8.30pm.

**Students in 11LWA, 11NRA, 11RWH, 11TSH** will attend Part 2 of the evening (Advice and Guidance for Future Destinations) from 6.30 – 7.30pm and Part 1 of the evening (Study Skills) from 7.30 – 8.30pm.

This event is open to all pupils, parents and carers in Year 11.
