Dear Parents/ Carers

As a result of the continued hot weather, we are making some temporary changes to our uniform policy. For the remainder of this week, students will no longer be required to wear ties to school. However, shirts are still expected to be tucked in, in order to maintain a smart appearance.

A significant number of students play football on the field at lunchtime. Students can change into their school PE kit shorts or skort if they wish to, during lunchtime, for playing sport. However, they must have changed back into their skirt or trousers in time for a punctual start to afternoon lessons at 2.05pm. They will be able to use the toilet cubicles for privacy whilst changing.

We would recommend that students who go outside at break and lunchtime wear sun screen. There are quite a lot of trees on the school field and many students have been sitting in the shade during break times. It is recommended that all students bring a bottle of water to school with them each day. There are several water fountains around school for refilling water bottles but we ask that this is done outside of lesson time to avoid disruption to learning.

If the hot weather continues into next week as indicated by the weather forecast, it is likely that these arrangements will remain in place. However, we will confirm this in a further email on Friday.
