We are delighted to announce that with funding totalling over £22000 from the Mersey Community Benefit Fund, The Inner Wheel and the Rotary Club of Frodsham & Helsby, modifications to the toilets in the corridor will provide a new, fully compliant, toilet for the disabled. The new toilet will provide easy access for mobility scooters & wheelchairs.
